



Counselor In Training (CIT) program– Answers to Frequently Asked Questions

- *The cost covers participation for the entire summer (up to 10 weeks).
- *The CIT program runs Week 2 (starts July 1) through Week 10 (starts August 26). CIT Training for New & Returning CIT's will take place in May/June and Week 1 of camp (June 24-28).
- *There is a 4-week minimum commitment. Anything less than 4 weeks and the CIT's don't have the opportunity to perfect their skills.
- *It is perfectly ok to switch off between being a camper and a CIT. Several CIT's enjoy attending Teen Trek or Dodgeball. Fees for these weeks of camp are additional.
- *Regarding the schedule and camp assignments: as part of their on-boarding process, CIT's will fill out an interest form. The weekly schedule is made using this information. Every effort is made to accommodate these requests! It's important that the CIT's experience a wide variety of camp experiences during the summer.
- *The CIT Coordinator will ask for a general idea of summer availability at the training events. It is perfectly understandable that this may change throughout the summer and the schedule can always be adjusted accordingly.
- *Training will take place prior to camp starting. Evening and/or weekend dates will be available. An online sign up will be sent out in late April/early May.
- *General CIT timeline: applications due March 31, interviews will start in early April, and training will take place in May and June.
